
## PREPARATION

### ATTACHING THE STAND

**IMPORTANT:** The stand of the TV must be assembled prior to usage.

1. Place TV unit face down on a soft and flat surface (blanket, foam, cloth, etc.) to Prevent any damage to the TV.
2. Fix the stand to the bottom of the TV with the 12 screws.


### PREPARING YOUR LED TV FOR WALL MOUNTING

We suggest that you keep your TV at least 2.36 inches (60 mm) from the wall to prevent cable interference. Before mounting your TV on the wall, you need to remove the stand.

For your safety, please use only with a UL listed wall mount bracket with minimum weight of the TV without stand.

To attach a wall mount bracket to your TV:

1. Remove the screws holding your TV to the stand.
2. Remove the stand from your TV.
3. Secure the wall mount bracket to the back of your TV using four screws. Follow the instructions of the user manual that came with the wall mount bracket to install.





4. Fix the wall mount screws (BM6x10mm/4pcs) into the rear side of the LEDTV ,using the torque of 8kgf,cm.

### TURNING ON THE TV

1. Install the stand and place the TV on a solid surface.




#### ! NOTE

- Ensure that the TV is placed in a position to allow free flow of air. Do not cover the ventilation openings on the back cover.
- To prevent any unsafe situations, no naked flame sources, such as lighted candles, should be placed on or in the vicinity.
- Avoid heat, direct sunlight and exposure to rain or water. The equipment shall not be exposed to dripping or splashing.

2. Connect the antenna cable or cable TV cable to the **ANT IN** aerial socket on the back of the TV set.

3. Power:

Plug the cord into a working power outlet.



1. Press the "←" and "TV" buttons at the bottom of the remote control for 5 seconds.
2. When the LED starts to flash, release it. The remote controller will send the pairing signal to the TV and display the information of the remote control on the right side of the screen.
3. Press the OK button to display the pairing. If the paired is displayed, the connection is successful.
4. If the couldn't pair appears, the connection fails. Wait 30 seconds and then press the "←" and "TV" buttons at the bottom of the remote control for 5 seconds to repeat the previous steps.
5. Press "←" button return to the previous menu.

## ADD AND USE OF MULTI MEDIA PLAYER





# HANDS FREE VOICE CONTROL



Switch to the left to open the Hands free Voice Control, and to the right to close.

1. Move the switch toward the center of the screen.  
(Open by default)



2. Operate the remote control and click the microphone icon. Select settings Google assistant, and select sign in or use assistant without sign in—Allow

3. Continue to click the microphone icon to conduct voice interaction through the wake-up word "Ok Google".

4. Click the microphone icon again. When the prompt "Google assistant is not ready!" is prompted, the system starts the voice module. After the prompt disappears, it can be used. For example, when we say "Ok Google, weather", Hands free voice indicator will light up and feed back the weather conditions.
